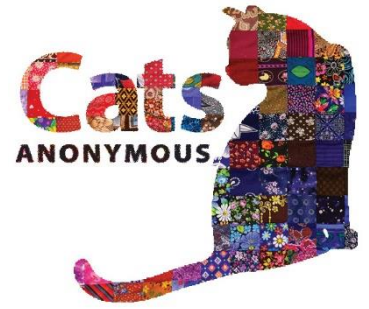

Covers do wear out over time, so we truly appreciate the help boosting our supply.

These are basic instructions. Sewers can come up with their own method to get the job done, and different styles and examples are available online.

What kind of material?

Almost any material that can be machine washed with hot water! We appreciate heavier covers in winter (fleece, canvas, even recycled blankets), lightweight in summer (cotton, recycled sheets, etc.). Cute covers surely bring a smile to volunteers' faces ... but even the weird, stained and downright ugly get the important job done! What an easy, fun and meaningful way to recycle, use up scraps, or bust the odds & ends in your fabric stash.

How much material?

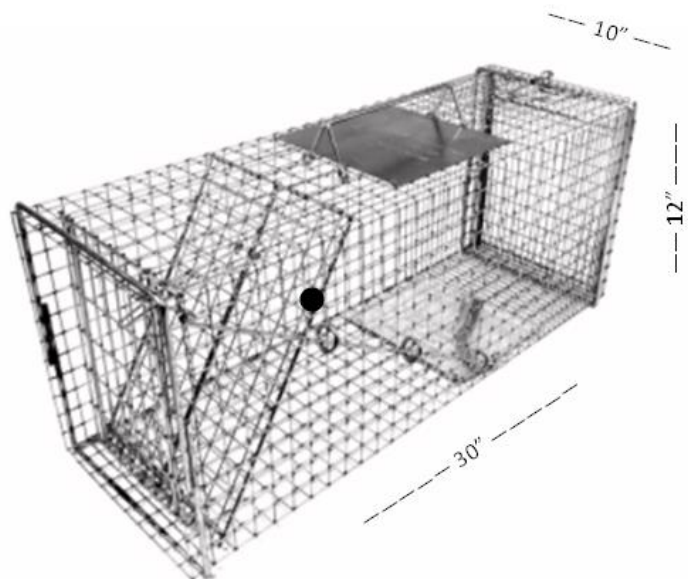
Ballpark 1½ yards of 44" wide. Finishing hems/edges makes a longer lasting cover that doesn't unravel in the wash – but of course some materials like fleece don't need a hem, or maybe you have a serger. It's a simple box shape, with doors on both long ends, and the top needs a hole for carrying handles to poke through. These are the dimensions of the exact style trap Cats Anonymous uses:

TOMAHAWK CAT TRAP MODEL 606NC

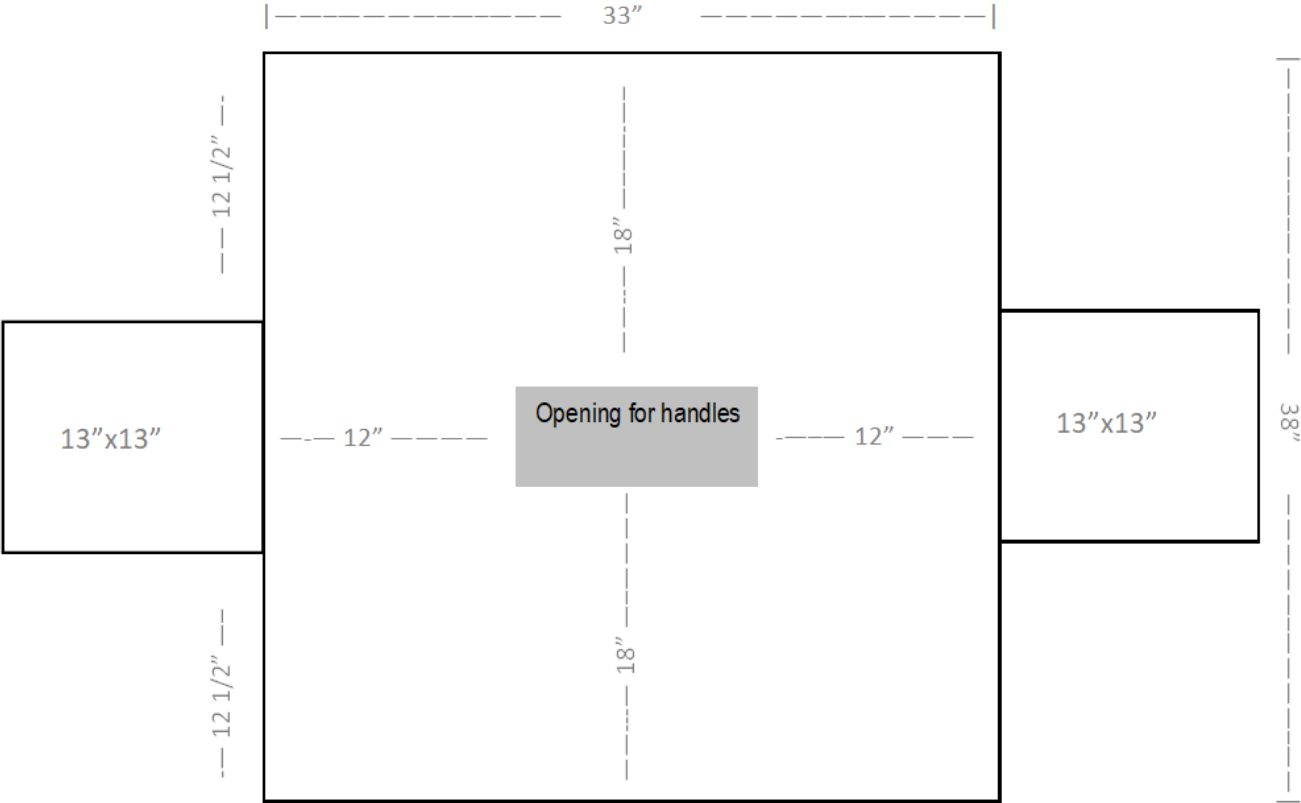
30"L x 10"W x 12"H

2 doors – so 10 x 12 ends need "flaps" for access

Double handle on top for sturdy carry
(need opening to ensure carry while cover is on)



Approximate FINISHED dimensions; handle opening roughly 2 1/2" x 9 1/2"



This is a tiny bit oversized to ensure covers still fit after lots of hot washing and drying. A little too big is always better than a bit too small. As long as the trap is covered on all sides except the bottom, there’s access the doors front & back, and the handles are easy to grab ... there's no wrong way!
